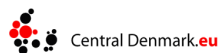


WHAT IS SOS-NETWORK?

The SOS network aims to contribute to the social inclusion of young people with special educational needs and social disadvantages into mainstream Vocational Education and Training, labour market and society. It intends to develop and introduce new concepts for approaching the issue of social inclusion and to provide teachers, trainers and others working with these young people in learning or job-related activities with adequate, well-proven and relevant methods and tools easily applicable in daily life.

The network expects to develop a partnership and networking strategy that will help to reduce early school leaving and by that means to increase the integration of students into the labour market and society

SOS network expects to reach 800 teachers/trainers, involve students by inviting them for consultations and presentations of the products/results and reach 6000 people through the network's dissemination actions.

So far, the network has involved more than 50 companies and other representatives as associated partners in order to increase the impact of the Project on society.

SOS NETWORK Objective 2:

To ensure Transition from education and training to the labour market.

Catalogue of Target Groups. This catalogue will include definitions and identified skills and competences for each target group.

Catalogue of 50 Interesting Practices, and will highlight the 15 Best Practices concerning social inclusion in Vocational Education and Training.

Catalogue of 15 Identified Methods and Tools. Those will be tested and the results of the testing phase will be included in a Test Report.

SOS NETWORK Objective 1:

To Reduce early school leaving.

MAJOR EVENTS

The Project will act in different ways to ensure its impacts. Therefore, within the project different events will be organised.

During the project life two thematic meetings will take place in order to define best practices and to reach a consensus on methods and tools.

Each partner will organise 3 Open Space Meetings. One of which will be aimed at increasing enterprise awareness.

ASeminar based in Brussels will take place. The topic of the Seminar will be Social Inclusion in Vocational Education and Training.

SOS Final conference will take place in March 2014 and will involve between 100 and 150 stakeholders dealing with social inclusion.

SOS NETWORK Objective 3:

To develop a Pan-European Network for people involved in Vocational Education and Training and Social Inclusion.
